

Clear Springs Campground – Covid 19

April 5, 2020

Our public washrooms have been closed (on March 16) until further notice.

Our office is not open to the public but we will speak to you through phone, email or at a distance from outside (tenants only). We are practicing isolation and social distancing for our safety and yours.

We are not open to public camping at this time. We are accepting camping reservation for the season but reserve the right to cancel reservations as Covid 19 conditions change. These cancellations will be with sufficient notice and be done through phone or email. We still hope to have a camping season if Covid 19 conditions improve and government restrictions are lifted.

We are temporarily closing the park to all visitors and guests until further notice. We will re-access this decision on May 1, 2020. In the event that we continue to see an increase of traffic (tenants and guests) we will have no choice but to close our gates. We would allow only essential visits such as propane delivery or tenant checks on lot. There will be no lot 4 sale viewings allowed during this time.

Please understand that these measures are to prevent community spread as in your community to our local community and vice versa. Tenants; please know that your lot and personal property are secure and protected. It is our policy to notify tenants of any issues that could arise and we ask that you contact us during business hours with any questions.

“We just don’t know if the infection curve will flatten, or if secondary breakouts will occur. We will have to make these important decisions as new information comes out. We are watching the Alberta Provincial campground sites/information as a guideline. We feel that the short term inconveniences out- weigh the long term consequences. We are in this together; do your part.”
